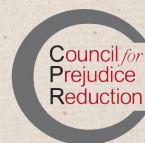
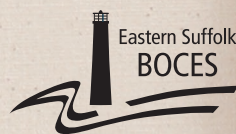

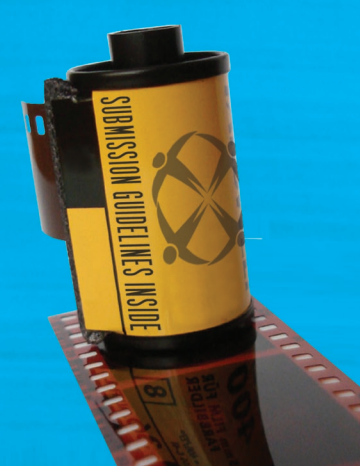

Embracing Our Differences™

**An Outdoor Art Exhibition Created with Artwork
Submitted by Artists Throughout Long Island**

Our goal is to spark community-wide discussions focusing upon the importance of diversity, acceptance and coexistence. Through the eyes and experiences of artists, we seek to demonstrate that:

- diversity enriches our lives;
- respect for differences in our thoughts and beliefs elevates the human experience; and
- active rejection of prejudice and hatred enhances our own freedom.

Embracing Our Differences begins on Monday, September 24, 2007 at 12:00 p.m. Opening day events will feature artists and musicians in a celebration of diversity.

The exhibition, consisting of 39 billboard-sized (16 feet wide by 12 feet high) artworks, will be displayed throughout the month of October 2007 at Heckscher Park in downtown Huntington Village. The Fall Festival is held during this period, typically attracting over 350,000 people to the park.

Since 2004, a similar project in Sarasota Fl. has been viewed by more than 250,000 visitors, including 13,000 students and teachers who participated in the discussion of the importance of diversity in our lives.

We invite you to participate in creating a society that is more inclusive for all. Please consider submitting a work of art and know that you are helping make a difference in the lives of many, especially those of our children.



WHAT'S THE THEME?

Artists are asked to submit their interpretations of the theme **EMBRACING OUR DIFFERENCES** in the format detailed below and are encouraged, but not required, to collaborate with artists in their own or other disciplines. For example, a photographer might work with a dancer, or a painter might work with a poet. Collaboration epitomizes the theme of *Embracing Our Differences*.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Long Island artists, professionals, amateurs, photographers, teachers, and students of all ages can participate. Just follow the guidelines below. You may submit more than one entry; however, no more than two images per artist will be chosen for display.

THE CRITERIA:

Final selections will be chosen based on artistic excellence in reflection of the theme *Embracing Our Differences*. Artists are encouraged to submit works relevant to Long Island. The artwork will also be evaluated on how effectively it will read outdoors when enlarged to billboard size – 16 feet wide by 12 feet high. Artists are encouraged to use bold saturated colors and strong lines. Final selections will be made by professional artists, curators and art professionals.

HOW TO SUBMIT:

For submission, please follow all requirements listed below:

1. Send a CD/DVD with artwork saved in the following format:
JPEG: 12-8/10 inches (12.8") wide x 8-8/10 inches (8.8") high, image saved at 300 dpi. or higher (for Mac & PC viewing).
Print your name and artwork title clearly on the CD.
2. Mail CD/DVD and signed release form (one for *each* artist involved in the development of the artwork) contained on the next page (additional release forms are available online) to:
